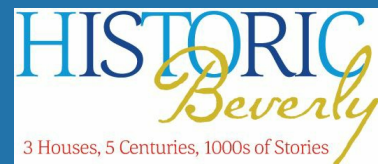

The founding of United Shoe Machinery Company in 1899 marked the beginning of automation and standardization in the shoe industry.
