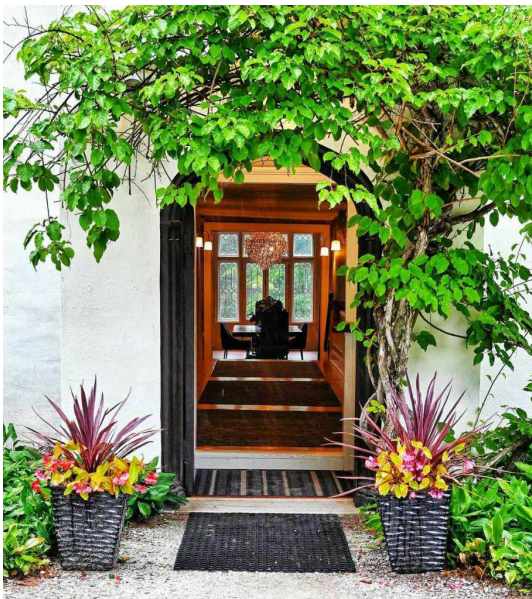
- East of the 500 building
